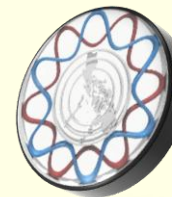

This is to encourage undergraduate students to actively pursue their research interests in the fields of biochemistry and molecular biology. Interested participants are requested to send their extended abstracts not later than September 15, 2010 for inclusion in the forum.

All papers will be reviewed for consideration. The abstract should be formatted according to the following guidelines:

- An abstract must have a maximum of 300 words, including 3 keywords for poster presentation.
- An extended abstract must have a maximum of 1000 words, maximum of 3 figures and/or tables and maximum of 5 references.
- It must be written in MS word (.doc) or Rich Text Format (.rtf), in English on an A4-size template with 1" margin on all sides.
- Text should be in 11-point Arial font; in single-spaced and justified paragraphs; double-spaced between paragraphs.
- Title of the paper must be in boldfaced capital letters and centered

- Name(s) of the author(s) must be centered with one-line space from the title. Presenter's name should be underlined.
- Author(s)' affiliation is centered and one-line space from the name(s) of the author(s); if more than one author, use superscript numbers to indicate affiliation.
- The abstract should contain an introduction, objectives, major findings and conclusion/implications.
- Please indicate if the abstract is for poster or Young Scientist Forum (YSF) presentation.

UP Manila is one of the seven constituent universities of the UP System and the Philippines' leading university in health sciences. It houses the Philippine General Hospital, the teaching hospital of the UP College of Medicine that caters to the poor and the underprivileged Filipinos.
